




Anyone without a completed form will not be allowed to participate at the WSA hosted events.

Amber Tip:

ONLINE CHECK-IN PROCESS:

New health and safety steps added to Online Check-In will significantly cut down processing time at the pier. Experience a much faster, more seamless boarding process when you complete all required steps listed below. Online Check-In for all guests is required to download your eDocs (boarding pass). Port security requires each guest to present their eDocs to enter the pier.

PLEASE NOTE: You will lose the opportunity to Check-in online 3 days prior to sailing.

Complete these steps in Online Check-In:

- Travel Documentation: Provide passport number or travel documentation information
- Flight Information: Provide airline details and purchase transfers to the pier and back to the airport.
- Onboard Payment Preferences: Select either credit card, debit card or cash
- **Take a Selfie Photo:** Use your computer webcam or mobile phone camera to capture your pre-cruise security photo. You can come back to this step on the Mobile app if you don't have a web cam.


These steps will be available 21 days prior to your sail date:

- Reserve an arrival time to check-in at the pier. You will only be allowed to enter the terminal during this time.
- Watch the Required Safety Video in advance to avoid large crowd gathering onboard. Learn important muster drill, life jacket and onboard safety procedures.

Get your eDocs

After completing Online Check-In for each guest, select "Download eDocs." Either print a copy or save a screenshot on your phone that includes the guest's name, terminal arrival time, ship, stateroom, and barcode. Port security will verify eDocs along with your passport/identification for port entry. You can download eDocs 21 days before your sailing once Online Check-In is done. Not presenting eDocs during embarkation will lead to extended waiting times at the port.

All specialty restaurants will have a cover charge. Cover charges are as follows: Steak, Teppanyaki / Hasuki, French, and Seafood have a \$60 cover charge. Brazil, Asian, Food Republic, and Sushi have a \$50 cover charge. Italian, BBQ, Pincho, and Mexican have a \$40 cover charge.



Tipping

Cruise lines, like Norwegian, include automatic tips either at time of booking or on your onboard account when disembarking for your stateroom steward. When ordering drinks at a bar or food at a specialty restaurant, gratuity will already be added to the bill. A few cruisers bring cash to tip for service that goes above and beyond high quality, but that is not expected by the staff.

Excursions off ship - driver and guide
Baggage porters when boarding the ship: ~\$1-\$2 per bag
Room attendant: can tip extra at beginning and/or end of week

Dress Code

Layering

You could have scorching hot temperatures during the day, but it's chilly at night on board as your ship is cruising between islands. You'll likely want to bring a lightweight sweater or cardigan for the evening time and the onboard air conditioning.

Cruise CasualFor Buffet and Regular Specialty Restaurants

- Sundresses.
- Casual dresses.
- Shorts or skirts.
- Capri pants or long pants.
- Khakis.
- Jeans (Not too faded or with holes)
- Casual shirts, such as a polo.

If you are dining at one of the outdoor restaurants or the buffet, you can opt for swimwear, but you'll need a pool coverup or shirt and footwear.




Smart CasualFor Dinner on The Waterfront & Upscale Specialty Restaurants

- Dresses.
- Pants or nice capris.
- Dress slacks.
- Polo shirts.
- Button-down shirts.
- Non-faded jeans.
- Heels or dress sandals.

- Skirts with blouses.

Not Allowed in Main Dining Rooms and Specialty Restaurants




- Baseball caps
